- 1) Attends school daily and arrives on time, ready for the day's learning experience
 - a) 3 unexcused absences or 10 total absences = chronic absenteeism
 - b) 3 tardies = 1 absence
- 2) Completes all homework assignments given by teachers
- 3) Reads daily to develop a love for reading and to improve literacy skills
- 4) Talk to your child, and discuss school experiences so that you are aware of your child's school life
- 5) Ask questions, so he/she can inform you if he/she needs additional support in any area or subject
- 6) Know that you expect him/her to succeed in school and go on to college or a career.

Please consider joining our school volunteer program as our students can greatly benefit from your involvement and contributions to the school's program and its operations. We seek volunteers to help us with the following activities:

- 1) Parent support in the classroom, please contact your child's classroom teacher for more information
